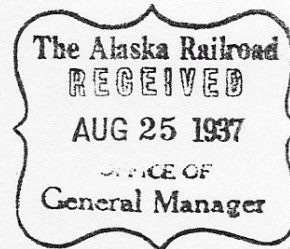

We just took in trade for one of our logging speeders a gaso-
line rail car, in which you might be interested.

Photograph of this car is enclosed. It is powered with a
White 4-cylinder truck motor, the body is all-steel, 24 feet long,
7½ feet wide. Windows are of plate glass. Seats are upholstered
in imitation leather, in perfect condition. There are ten double
seats, and one across the back end. In the driver's cab, there are
wooden seats. The car will accommodate 35 or 40 people without crowding.

This machine was built to order for one of Washington's largest
logging concerns, and used on its 40-mile main line until it got too
small.

We do not yet have full details, but if you are interested, we
will send you complete specifications soon. We can sell it for a
price that represents less than 20 per cent of the original cost.
